(1 John 5:7)*

## 2. What Are the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit?

### A. In the \_\_\_\_\_

*“Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.” (John 16:7-11)*

- To bring them to Christ
- To convict (convince) them of sin by the law (God’s Word) and a Christian’s testimony (salt and light) so that the unbeliever sees they need a Saviour.

*“And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.” (Romans 8:28-29)*

- Conforms them

### Three Ways the Holy Spirit Conforms a Believer

#### 1. Comforts Them

*“And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; But the*

*Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.” (John 14:16, 26)*

**2. Convicts Them Specifically and Immediately**

**3. Communicate to Them and for Them**

*“Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.” (Romans 8:26)*

*I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.” (Galatians 2:20)*

**C. Baptism of the Holy Spirit at \_\_\_\_\_**

*“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.” (Romans 6:3-4)*

- The question is not “How much of the Holy Spirit you have,” but “How much He has of you.” The baptism of the Holy Spirit occurred at the very moment you were saved.

**4. How Am I \_\_\_\_\_ by the Holy Spirit?**

*“And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;” (Ephesians 5:18)*

**A. Filling Has to Do with \_\_\_\_\_ .** You cannot be filled with the Spirit until He controls every area of your life. Being Spirit-filled is a moment by moment experience.
